#### JUROR'S STATEMENT

Photography's ability to transform a specific detail of the world into a form of poetics filled with allegory and metaphor is the beauty of the medium. When a picture's form and content create an image that invites us to look past it's surface, ask more questions and evoke an unnamed emotion rather than attempt to answer some false idea of objective truth, that is when it's an image worth stopping to look at. It's a challenge to the artist to make new pictures in a world where an estimated 1.3 billion images are created a day. Cheers to these new pictures for giving us a reason to stop and look.
